3 Ways to Pray for People in Your Harvest Field

- 1) That their heart would be open to Jesus
- 2) That God would send people into their life to represent Jesus.
- 3) That he would show YOU how YOU can represent Jesus to them.

- 1) Start with Prayer
- 2) Engage with People of Peace



A Person of Peace...

Is someone who God has prepared ahead of time to hear the message of the gospel through you. They:

- Welcome you into their life
- are open to the Message of Jesus
- serve you even as you serve them

Engaging People of Peace

Identify yourself with Jesus



If you go out representing Jesus (in his name, with his authority) then it's true when he says: "If they welcome you, they welcome me. If they reject you, they reject me." But if you are ashamed of Jesus or the gospel in any way, if we are unwilling to experience the same kind of scorn and opposition that Jesus faced, you won't be able to perceive the Person of Peace, because that person is primed and ready to receive Jesus.... And you won't look like Jesus to them. You [have] essentially [gone] out "in your own name," not on behalf of Christ.
